You can also prepare by:

Meeting with your local vet and discussing:

- Your concerns
- Their understanding of the situation and level of preparedness
- The resources available to each party (Vets will have information coming onto the NZVA website)
- Scenarios IF HPAI is present in NZ think of some what if scenarios and have a discussion.
- What support you need from them (and vice versa)
- Messaging to the public

Meeting with your local council to discuss:

- Their response plans if there is an outbreak/incursion of HPAI
- Their body disposal plans –
- Your concerns
- What support you need from them (and vice versa)
